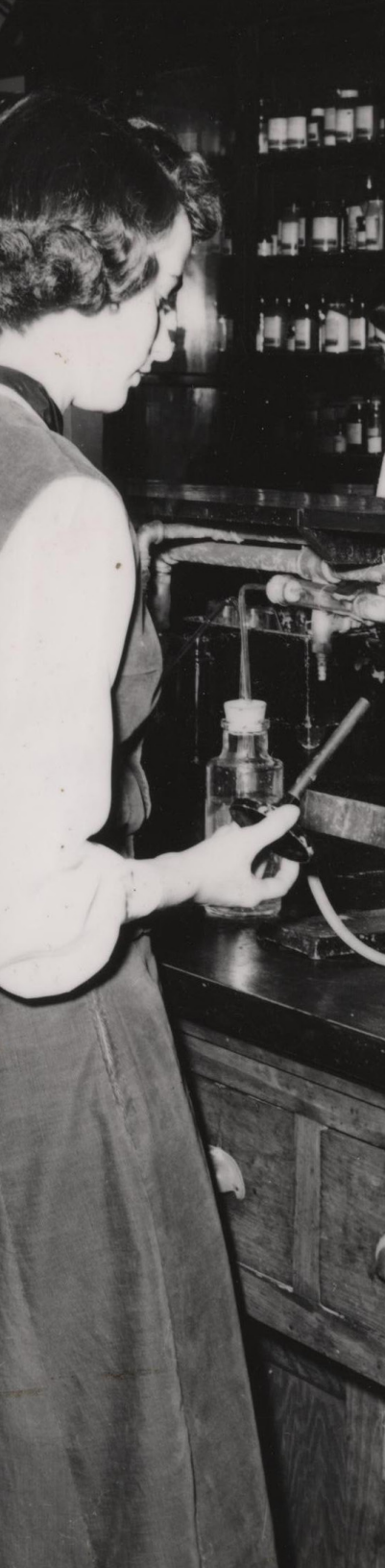

## **A story that, with your help, we can share with everyone who visits our campus.**

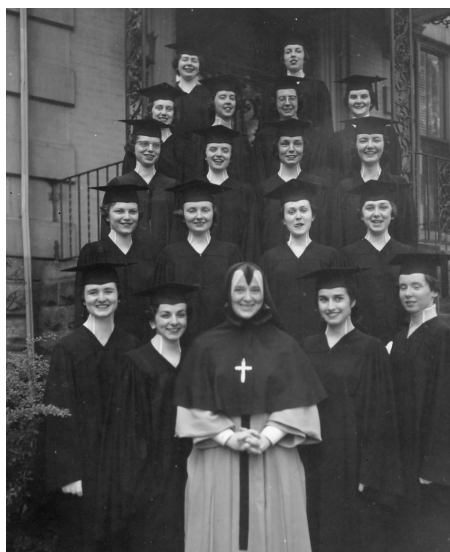
In the summer of 2020, on the first floor of Koessler Administration Building, a new interactive exhibit will be constructed to showcase our mission, history and heritage. Prospective students, alumni and guests will have the opportunity to experience our story from the very beginning. The Boethea Room will serve as a mission museum, housing artifacts and memorabilia which illuminate the journeys of D'Youville students and faculty throughout the 20th century as they lived out our heritage of education and service.
